REPACK IS ON TRACK

The FCC has approved our new construction permits for the Marion and Delaware stations. The transmitter in Marion will move to channel 25 and the transmitter in Delaware will move to channel 32. Our request for reimbursement of all expenses involved in the move has been received by the FCC. Starting in October we should be able to send expense invoices to the FCC and they will electronically transfer funds to cover those invoices. At least that is how it is supposed to work.

Two weeks ago we received an urgent phone call from the CBS television network. A special notification letter that is to go to all stations that will be receiving reimbursement funds and that should have come to the COACB was delivered to CBS and they had not received any of the letters that should have come to them. They were asking if we had received any of their letters. We had not. They are in line to receive hundreds of millions in reimbursement funds and the COACB is in line to receive a tiny portion compared to theirs. I just had to say it. It sure sounds good to me if we receive your money and you receive ours. For some reason they don't like that idea.

No money will transfer until October and I think the FCC now has everything straightened out but I can still dream of that massive \$500,000,000 electronic transfer!

OLD TIME PORK CAKE

1 pound salt pork (all fat); 1 pint boiling water; 4 cups sugar; ½ cup molasses; 1 egg; 1 teaspoon soda; 1 teaspoon nutmeg; 1 teaspoon cinnamon; 1 teaspoon cloves; 1 pound raisins; 6 cups flour.

Put pork through grinder. Pour boiling water over it and let stand till luke warm. Stir in sugar, spices, soda, well beaten eggs and molasses. Sift flour and add to pork mixture. Mix well. Bake 2 hours in well greased pan in 300 degree oven. Especially good for picnics or outdoor meals.

MEXICAN PASTA SALAD

¾ cup mayonnaise; ¾ cup mild or medium salsa; 1 teaspoon garlic salt; 1/8 teaspoon pepper; ½ cup dried onion; 8 ounces cooked pasta, any kind, rinsed with cold water and drained; cubes of cheddar cheese (optional).

In a large bowl combine the mayonnaise, garlic salt and pepper. Add the pasta, salsa and onion. Toss to coat. May add cubes of cheddar cheese for additional flavor. Cover and chill for one hour.
