Spring is just around the corner, get ready for our Annual Spring Telethon and Auction being held on March 29 through April 1 th.

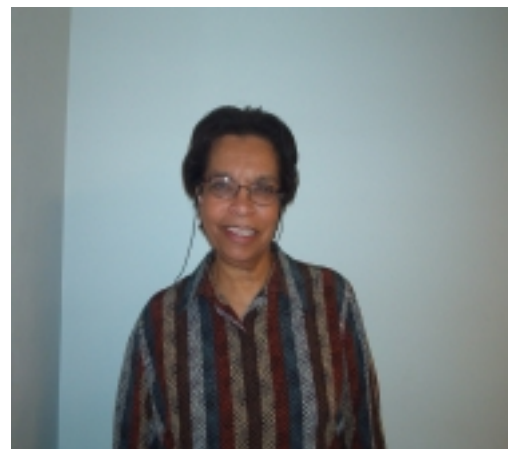

Try These Recipes

HONEY LAYER CAKE

THELMA AIKEN

2 cups cake flour; ¼ teaspoon salt; 1 teaspoon soda; ½ teaspoon ginger; ½ teaspoon cinnamon; ½ cup shortening; 1 cup honey; 1 egg separated; 2 tablespoons lemon juice or vinegar plus enough milk to make ½ cup liquid.

Sift, then measure flour; sift 3 times with salt and spices. Cream shortening, add honey gradually, beating thoroughly. Add dry ingredients alternately with milk mixture. Blend thoroughly. Blend in stiffen beaten egg white. Pour into 2 greased 1-inch cake pans. Bake in 350 degree oven for 30 to 35 minutes. Cool and frost.

QUICK STRAWBERRY FROSTING

1 egg white; 1/8 teaspoon salt; 1 cup strawberry preserves or any tart jam or jelly; Combine and beat until frosting will stand in peaks. Spread on cake.

ORANGE SALAD

1 – 8 oz can crushed pineapple, drained; 1 – 3 oz package orange Jell; 1 – 12 oz carton small curd cottage cheese; 1 – 8 oz carton Cool Whip

Mix pineapple, orange Jello and cottage cheese. Fold in Cool Whip and chill until ready to serve.

CHILI BY CORBLE RATLIFF

1 pound ground beef
1 cup chopped onion
1 cup green pepper
2 - 11 ounce tomato soup with rice
1 - 14 ounce kidney beans (undrained)
2 tablespoons chili powder
1 tablespoon vinegar
Shredded cheddar cheese
Garlic

In five quart dutch oven over medium heat, cook beef, onion, green pepper and garlic until meat is browned and the vegetables are tender. Drain. Stir in tomato soup, kidney beans, chili powder and vinegar. Heat to boiling.

ANGEL FOOD DESSERT

2 cans (20 oz. ea.) unsweetened crushed pineapple, drained; 4 medium firm bananas, sliced; 1 loaf (10 ½ oz.) angel food cake, cut into 1 inch cubes; 3 cups cold fat free milk; 2 packages (1 oz. ea.) sugar free instant vanilla pudding mix; 1 carton (8 oz.) frozen reduced fat whipped topping, thawed; ½ cup pecans toasted

Place the pineapple in a bowl; gently fold in bananas. Place cake cubes in a 13 in. x 9 in. 2 in dish; spoon fruit over cake. In a bowl, whisk milk and pudding mixes for 2 minutes. Let stand for 2 minutes or until soft set. Spread over fruit. Carefully spread whipped topping over pudding. Sprinkle with pecans. Cover and refrigerate for at least 2 hours before serving.

SPAGHETTI BAKE

2-10 oz. packages spaghetti, cooked and drained; 1 large onion, chopped; 4 cans tomato soup; 2 cans water; 1 can whole mushrooms; 3-4 pounds ground beef; 2 small green peppers, chopped; 2 teaspoons chili powder; ½ pound grated cheese; 1 teaspoon worchestershire sauce; 1 teaspoon oregano; 1 teaspoon sweet basil; 2 teaspoons garlic powder; salt and pepper to taste.

Saute ground beef and onions with salt, pepper and chili powder. Drain excess liquid. Pour these and all other ingredients, except cheese, into a large roaster pan. Mix well. Let stand for 5 to 6 hours. Sprinkle with grated cheese. Heat in 350 degree oven for 45 minutes. Serves 24.
